On the first day of Unleavened Bread, when the Passover lamb was sacrificed, His disciples said to Jesus, 'Where do you want us to go and make the preparations for you to eat the Passover?' The disciples set out and went to the city and found everything as He had told them, and prepared the Passover. And as they were eating He took some bread, and when He had said the blessing He broke it and gave it to them. 'Take it,' He said 'this is My Body.' Then He took a cup, and when He had returned thanks He gave it to them, and all drank from it, and He said to them, 'This is My Blood, the blood of the covenant, which is to be poured out for many. I tell you solemnly, I shall not drink any more wine until the day I drink the new wine in the kingdom of God.' After psalms had been sung they left for the Mount of Olives.
