We are reminded by Saint Paul that "The Lord is very near". As pilgrims, hopefully awaiting His coming in the incarnation, we gather to celebrate the Eucharist, praying that the peace of God will guard our hearts in Christ Jesus.

When all the people asked John, 'What must we do?' he answered, 'If anyone has two tunics he must share with the man who has none, and the one with something to eat must do the same.' There were tax collectors too who came for baptism, and these said to him, 'Master, what must we do?' He said to them, 'Exact no more than your rate.'
